### New Booster Seat Law

Governor Patrick signed [St.2008, c.79](#), An Act Relative to Child Passenger Safety. Under the new law, effective May 1, 2008, "No child under the age of eight and measuring less than fifty-seven inches in height shall ride as a passenger in a motor vehicle in any way unless such child is properly fastened and secured, according to the manufacturer's instructions, by a child passenger restraint."
