## STUDENT RECORDS

According to the Department of Education's *Student Records Regulations*, your transcript must be maintained by the school department and may only be destroyed 60 years following your graduation.

The remainder of the information in your guidance folder is considered a "temporary record." If you would like to have your temporary record, which is composed of past report cards and test scores, please see your counselor in the Guidance Office **\*\*before Friday, May 16, 2008**. If you do not collect your **temporary record, it will be destroyed within five years of graduation**.

## MEDICAL RECORDS

According to the Department of Education's *Student Records Regulations* student health records are also considered temporary records. Students who are 18 years old at the time of graduation will sign out the original health record from the school at graduation practice. Students who are not yet 18 years old will be given immunization information and can have their parents sign out their health records. Students who are not yet 18 may elect to return to the school to get them when they turn 18. **Student health records not picked up will be destroyed five years after graduation.**

Medications stored here at AHS are to be picked up by students during graduation rehearsals.

## GRADUATION INFORMATION

Distribution of graduation tickets will take place on **Thursday, May 29**, at the second marching rehearsal. Each graduate will receive **four** graduation tickets in case the ceremony must be held in the gymnasium. Sadly, there are NO extra seats in the gymnasium. Hold on to your tickets... if lost, they cannot be replaced.

If graduation is outside, there is plenty of extra seating in the bleachers. Extra chairs may be brought to the area next to the bleachers and standing room is unlimited. Handicap seating is available but it is limited.
