

## **2019 CAMPUS PROGRAMS SPRING THEATER ARTS PROGRAM**

**Registration for the Freetown Lakeville Campus Programs Theater Arts program for students in grades K-8 will be held on Wednesday, February 6, at the Freetown Lakeville Middle School cafeteria from 5:00 – 7:00 p.m.**

The cost for the program (which includes acting, singing, dancing and arts and crafts) is \$100.00 per child. If there are two or more siblings, the cost is \$95.00 per child. There will be an additional charge for costumes.

Regular rehearsals will be held on Wednesday nights starting on February 13 at the Freetown Lakeville Middle School. Rehearsals for grades K-4 are from 6:00 to 7:00 p.m. and grades 5-8 are 7:00 to 8:30 p.m. There may be extra rehearsals on Tuesdays for grades 5-8. Please keep the extra rehearsals in mind when trying out for parts.

**We add rehearsals the week before show week and every night of show week. Show week for grades 5-8 will be dress rehearsal every night, which is mandatory.** Grades K-4 will have a costume check on Monday night of show week. The entire costume needs to be brought in for approval. They do not need to wear them. Each child will be in two performances which will be held on Saturday April 27, 2019, at 7:00 pm. and the second performance will be on Sunday, April 28, 2019, at 1:00 pm. at the Apponequet Regional High School. There is a very good chance we may be switching the order of the shows on Sunday which means we would have the middle school students perform first. However, all children still need to be at the high school a half hour before the performance. Children with wireless mics must report to the sound booth in costume one hour before show time.

We will again be looking for volunteers to help with the shows. There will be a sign-up sheet at registration. Unfortunately, parents cannot stay during rehearsals unless they are volunteering. Anyone volunteering cannot bring their children that are not part of the show with them. All volunteers must be CORI'd and fingerprinted. You can go to the George R. Austin Intermediate School to get CORI'd. If you need information on fingerprinting, please let me know. You CANNOT volunteer unless your CORI has been approved. Parents are not allowed to stay in the lobby while the children are rehearsing.
