Welcome to **Kids Café Summer Camp!** The purpose of **Kids Cafe** is to provide parents with a quality summer camp that incorporates enrichment classes in the morning with meaningful activities, supervised free choice and directed play in the afternoon. Kids Café Summer Camp is located at Austin Intermediate School.

So what’s brewing this summer at Kids Café? Although we are still in a pandemic for Covid-19 we will adhere to all of the CDC, State and Local guidelines should the need arise. We will update any changes in policies and procedures as they occur. As of now We Are Mask Free . In order to keep everyone healthy please keep your child home if they are sick.

We will be taking full time campers first. **Full time means full days Monday through Friday, and for the entire Summer.** Once those spots are filled we will take campers needing less days but still all sessions. If you wish to pay for a full week and attend less time in order to hold your spot that is acceptable. We will fill as many slots that are available. There is a 3day minimum per week 6 days per session.

We will still offer a unique balance of academics, hands-on learning and rip-roarin’ fun designed to enhance each child’s social, emotional, physical and intellectual growth. In this brochure you will find an assortment of exciting and creative classes to choose from. You can also attend the Community Recreation Sports Camps in the morning and then attend Kids Café in the afternoon for a summer blend of fun and excitement.

In the morning, campers should choose an area of interest or an area that needs support. These classes include science experiments, nature, dance, reading and more. They will never know but they are learning by doing!!! The same class will meet for the entire two week session. We will make every effort to accommodate campers first choice. If a class reaches capacity, campers will then be given their secondary choices. Classes are subject to change. There are no refunds.

In the afternoon, it’s fun in the sun or cool in the shade. There will be arts & crafts, water sports, wild n’ crazy games, theme days, and special events. **Campers are grouped according to the grade they will be entering in September.**
