Does my child have any new respiratory symptoms such as a runny nose, nasal congestion (stuffy nose) or headache? YES _____ NO _____

IF YOU ANSWER YES TO ANY OF THESE QUESTIONS AND YOUR CHILD IS NOT VACCINATED YOUR CHILD MUST BE KEPT HOME FROM SCHOOL AND YOU SHOULD CONSULT YOUR HEALTHCARE PROVIDER FOR ASSESSMENT, AND POSSIBLE COVID19 TESTING AND EVALUATION. **IN ADDITION PLEASE NOTIFY THE SCHOOL NURSE IN YOUR CHILD'S SCHOOL IF YOUR CHILD IS VACCINATED A "YES" TO ANY OF THE UNDERLINED QUESTIONS STILL REQUIRES YOUR CHILD TO STAY HOME AND GET COVID19 TESTING. **PLEASE NOTIFY THE NURSE IN YOUR CHILD'S SCHOOL****

PLEASE NOTE: the BOLDED symptoms in the above questions are primary COVID19 symptoms and any one of them alone indicates COVID testing is needed.

A negative COVID-19 test and resolution of symptoms, will be required for return to school unless a health care provider provides an alternate diagnosis
If the test is positive, then he/she may return no sooner than 10 days from onset of symptoms with resolution of fever (<100.0 F without use of anti-fever medications)
