Welcome to **Kids Café Summer Camp!** The purpose of Kids Café is to provide parents with a quality summer camp that incorporates enrichment classes in the morning with meaningful activities, supervised free choice and directed play in the afternoon. **Kids Café Summer Camp is located at Austin Intermediate School.**

So what's brewing this summer at Kids Café? A unique balance of academics, hands-on learning and rip-roaring fun designed to enhance each child's social, emotional, physical and intellectual growth. In this brochure you will find an assortment of exciting and creative classes to choose from. You can also attend the Community Recreation Sports Camps in the morning and then attend Kids Café in the afternoon for a summer blend of fun and excitement.

In the morning, campers should choose an area of interest or an area that needs support. These classes include science experiments, nature, dance, reading and more. They will never know but they are learning by doing!!! The same class will meet for the entire two week session. We will make every effort to accommodate campers first choice.
