## Driving Privileges

**The use of private automobiles by students as transportation to and from school is considered by school authorities as a special privilege. When permission to drive to school is granted, said privilege shall be governed by the following rules and regulations.**

1. These rules apply to all students driving any sort of motor vehicle, including cars, trucks, vans, and motorcycles.
2. Students driving their own vehicles to school shall not be tardy to school. Excessive tardiness shall be cause for revoking driving privileges.
3. **If a student drives or parks on school district grounds while driving privileges are suspended, the vehicle will be towed at the owner's expense.**
4. Motor vehicles shall be driven with care, especially on school property (the parking lot and driveways).
5. Reckless or careless driving which is reported by teachers, police, bus drivers, or other responsible parties may result in a student's loss of driving privileges for a period of time as determined by the school administration.
6. Smoking is not permitted in cars while they are on school grounds.
7. Abusing driving privileges by skipping school (including detention), leaving school early without proper dismissal or failure to park in designated space shall be cause for losing driving privileges for a period of time as determined by the school administration.
8. Students will not congregate in the parking lot, but will enter the building promptly upon arrival.
9. Student drivers shall not interfere in any way with the operation of the busses entering or departing school grounds.
10. Students will be assigned parking spaces. Students must register their cars; appropriately display their parking sticker and park in the designated space. Students may be placed on a waiting list if all spaces have been assigned.
11. At the beginning of the school year, students will have two weeks to register their vehicles through the Main Office. **All outstanding school debts must be paid prior to registering a vehicle.** The cost of each sticker remains \$1.00 for the year, and each parking space costs \$50.00. As students acquire new cars throughout the year, they need to register them to assure that only appropriate vehicles are in our parking lot. Unregistered vehicles and those parked inappropriately may be towed at owner's expense.
12. Absolutely **NO** switching, sharing, selling or giving away your parking space.
13. Once parked in designated parking areas, students may not move their vehicles to any other areas on grounds nor may they visit their vehicles at any time during the school day without administrative approval.
14. It is understood that the cars of students while on school property may be searched based on reasonable suspicion determined by a school administrator.
