Student Records: According to the Department of Education's *Student Records Regulations*, your transcript must be maintained by the school department and may only be destroyed 60 years following your graduation. The remainder of the information in your guidance folder is considered a "temporary record." If you would like to have your temporary record, which is composed of past report cards and test scores, please see your counselor in the Guidance Office **before Friday, May 10, 2019**. If you do not collect your temporary record, it will be destroyed within five years of graduation.

Medical Records: According to the Department of Education's *Student Records Regulations* student health records are also considered temporary records. Students who are 18 years old at the time of graduation will sign out the original health record from the school at graduation rehearsal. Students who are not yet 18 years old will be given immunization information and can have their parents sign out their health records. Students who are not yet 18 may elect to return to the school to get them when they turn 18. Student health records not picked up will be destroyed five years after graduation. Medications stored here at ARHS are to be picked up by students during graduation rehearsals.

Distribution of graduation tickets will take place on **Thursday, June 6th**, at the second marching rehearsal. Each graduate will receive **SIX** graduation tickets in case the ceremony must be held in the gymnasium. **FOUR** of the tickets are for gymnasium seating. **TWO** of the tickets are for viewing the Live Stream in the Auditorium/Lecture Hall. Hold onto your tickets... if lost, they cannot be replaced. **Tickets are only necessary for indoor graduation.**

If graduation is outside, **tickets are not needed**, as there is plenty of extra seating in the bleachers. Extra chairs may be brought to the area next to the bleachers and standing room is unlimited. Handicapped seating is available but it is limited.

A OneCall Phone Message will go out by Noon on the day of Graduation indicating whether the ceremony will be held Outdoors or Indoors.

Sports & Extra-Curricular Activities:

Seniors who have sports commitments/extra-curricular activities **MUST** stay **ALL DAY** on Friday, May 24th

Seniors who have sports commitments/extra-curricular activities **MUST** stay a **Minimum of Periods E through A** on Tuesday

Seniors who have sports commitments/extra-curricular activities **MUST** stay a **Minimum of Periods D through F** on Wednesday

X = Seniors Do Not Need to be at ARHS

Seniors with an average of 90 or above in some classes **may be** exempt from those courses' final exams.

Seniors who are exempt **must attend classes until the exam period**, otherwise, missing a class counts as an absence in that class.

Seniors who are exempt are not required to attend that exam period. If it is a last period exam, seniors may leave the building.

If it is not a last period exam, seniors must go to the cafeteria. Follow all Senior Privilege expectations for May 24th – 29th.
