Highlights: A four-year starter, Jenny led the Lady Lakers Teams to four South Coast Conference basketball titles, compiling an impressive record (including tournament games) of 85 wins and 8 losses. Her career statistics consistently rank her as one of our top female ballplayers: 1,169 points - 3rd all-time highest under Coach Dan Rose, 332 steals - 1st all time, 48% field-goal percentage - 1st all-time, 303 assists - 2nd all-time, and 683 rebounds - 4th all-time.

Highlights: A three-year starter and member of the 1999 State Championship Team, Jenny graduated with a .405 batting average in the record books (.429 her senior year) and supported her prowess at the plate with a .600 on-base percentage, 65 RBI's and a near perfect 52 of 53 stolen bases.
