Meaghan finished senior year with three more prestigious accolades when she was named the recipient of the Boston Globe All Scholastic Award for Indoor/Outdoor Track, the Brockton Enterprise Track Athlete of the Year, and the recipient of the Lawrence Pelletier Award for the top female student athlete in the Class of 2006.

She earned her BS in Biology at Boston College - but not before recording several of the school's top all-time Track and Field performances (indoors: 5th in 55M, 3rd in 1600M Relay, 5th 1600M Relay and outdoors: 4th in the 400M Relay) - and holds an MS in Nursing (RN/NP Women's Health 2012).
