

# FLMS Summer Reading

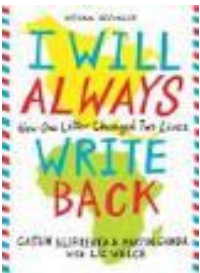
## Book Titles for 2020

Note-taking templates are available on the district website. Participation in summer reading based assessments will count as part of the students' first term grade.



### **6th Grade Summer Reading Requirements:**

Students must read Fish in a Tree by Lynda Mullaly Hunt. It is suggested, but not required, that students take chapter notes to assist with participation in literature circles in September.



### **7th & 8th Grade Summer Reading Requirements**

Students must read I Will Always Write Back: How One Letter Changed Two Lives by Caitlin Alifirenka & Martin Ganda with Liz Welch. It is suggested, but not required, that students take chapter notes to assist with discussion and assessments in September.
